

Referral packet: provider network D1-00004

This packet describes public records and dates. It does not assert fraud, intent or guilt. Each finding cites the numbered records at the end, and the section Rule out first lists the ordinary explanations a reviewer must eliminate before any action.

Summary

Public records show seven home health agencies clustered around Glendale, California, with four companies incorporated inside one 90-day window in 2021, one owner appearing on three of the providers, up to five providers sharing a single address, and one provider located in the same building as an entity on the Medicare revocation list. The combination of shared ownership, a shared address, a formation burst, and co-location with a revoked entity warrants a records request and verification of enrollment disclosures under **42 CFR 455.104** and site visits under **42 CFR 455.432**.

Description

This packet covers a group of seven home health agencies in and around Glendale, California, that public records link together. Four of the companies were set up within a single 90-day stretch between **May 13, 2021** and **July 27, 2021**, and five of the seven were formed in 2021 or later. One owner is listed on three of the providers, and as many as five of them use the same address. One of them, Supreme Home Care Services Inc, sits in the same building as Deluxe Hospice Care, which appears on the Medicare revocation list with an action dated **April 9, 2026**. Together the providers billed Medicaid **\$220** in 2024 and received **\$379,967** in Medicare hospice and home health payments in 2023.

What the records show

- 01 Provider network D1-00004 consists of 7 home health agencies around Glendale, CA, with a network score of 78 of 100, ranked 4 nationally.

Records 1 (clusters)

- 02 4 separate companies in the network were incorporated within one 90-day window, between 2021-05-13 and 2021-07-27.

- 03 1 owner appears on three or more of these providers, and the most connected owner sits on 3 of them.

- 04 Up to 5 providers share one address.
Records 4 (network facts)
- 05 Supreme Home Care Services Inc is in the same building as Deluxe Hospice Care, which appears on the Medicare revocation list with an action dated 2026-04-09, and 1 provider here shares an address with a revoked or excluded entity.
Records 5 (network facts)
- 06 5 of the providers were formed in 2021 or later, and the share of companies formed in 2021 or later is **71%**, in the top **3%** of networks in the risky direction.
Records 6 (network facts), 11 (factor desk)
- 07 The share of providers whose NPI was issued within six months of incorporation is **100%**, in the top **5%** of networks in the risky direction.
Records 13 (factor desk)
- 08 The share of providers at an address hosting eight or more enrollments is **14%**, in the top **4%** of networks in the risky direction.
Records 12 (factor desk)
- 09 Median company age in the network is 5.2 years, in the top **2%** of networks in the risky direction.

- 10 The county has 21.2 providers of this kind per 10,000 Medicare fee-for-service beneficiaries, above the national norm, and county saturation changed **40%** over three years, in the top **8%** of networks in the risky direction.

- 11 The providers billed Medicaid **\$220** in 2024 and received **\$379,967** in Medicare hospice and home health payments in 2023.

- 12 Bliss Home Health Care, Inc. (NPI **1952781791**, La Crescenta, CA) was incorporated 2015-01-27 and billed Medicaid **\$220** in 2024.

- 13 Brilliance Home Health Inc (NPI **1407426620**, La Crescenta, CA) and Los Care Homehealth Inc (NPI **1619541703**, La Crescenta, CA) had no Medicaid billing in 2024.
Records 17 (network members), 18 (network members)
- 14 Rapid Home Health Care Inc (NPI **1275203101**, Glendale, CA) was incorporated 2021-07-01 and Rely Home Health Inc (NPI **1215601513**, Glendale, CA) was incorporated 2021-07-27, and neither billed Medicaid in 2024.

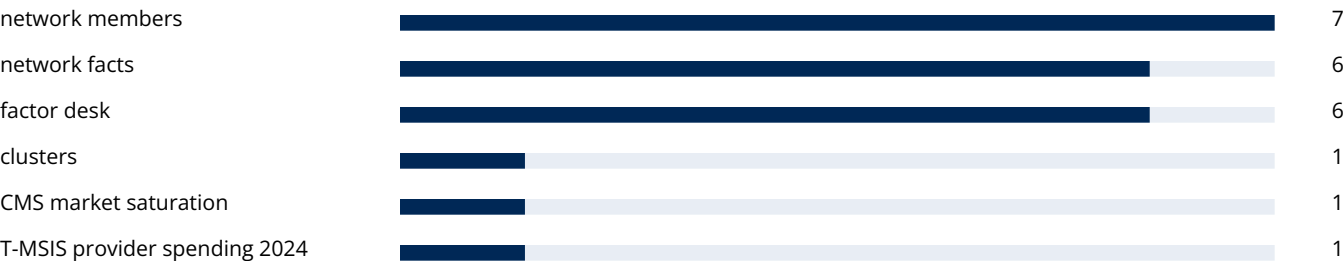
15 Urgent Home Health Services (NPI 1497410336, Glendale, CA) was incorporated 2021-09-12 and Supreme Home Care Services Inc (NPI 1871193169, Glendale, CA) was incorporated 2020-08-13, and neither billed Medicaid in 2024.

Records 21 (network members), 22 (network members)

Regulations this relates to

- 42 CFR 455.104 providers must disclose every person with an ownership or control interest of 5 percent or more, managing employees, and family or business relationships among them; the agency must obtain the disclosures before enrolling and at revalidation.
- 42 CFR 455.432 the State Medicaid agency must conduct pre-enrollment and post-enrollment site visits of providers designated as moderate or high risk to verify that the information submitted is accurate and to determine compliance with enrollment requirements.
- 42 CFR 455.450 screening levels; newly enrolling home health agencies and providers subject to a payment suspension or previously excluded are screened at the high risk level (fingerprint criminal background checks and site visits).
- 42 CFR 424.518 Medicare screening levels; newly enrolling home health agencies and hospices are screened at the high level (fingerprint background checks and site visits).
- 42 CFR 455.416(g) the agency may terminate or deny enrollment if the provider falsified any information on the application or the identity of the applicant cannot be verified.
- 42 CFR 455.416(c) the State Medicaid agency must deny or terminate the enrollment of any provider that is terminated on or after January 1, 2011 under Medicare or under the Medicaid program or CHIP of any other State and is included in the termination database under 455.417.

Recommended next step

Request the full ownership and control disclosures for all seven providers under 42 CFR 455.104, including every person with a 5 percent or more ownership or control interest, managing employees, and any family or business relationships among them, and compare the disclosures across the network to test the reported single owner on three providers. Order pre-enrollment or post-enrollment site visits at the shared address and at the building housing Supreme Home Care Services Inc and Deluxe Hospice Care under 42 CFR 455.432 to verify that the submitted address and operational information are accurate. Confirm that each home health agency was screened at the high risk level with fingerprint criminal background checks and site visits under 42 CFR 455.450 and 42 CFR 424.518. Check the Medicare revocation and termination databases for any affiliation between these providers and Deluxe Hospice Care and apply 42 CFR 455.416(c) if any provider is included in the termination database,

and consider **42 CFR 455.416(g)** if application information cannot be verified. Refer to the state Medicaid program integrity unit and the plan special investigations unit for coordinated review of the Medicare payments of **\$379,967** in 2023 alongside the Medicaid enrollment records.

Rule out first

- Shared addresses are common in medical office buildings and executive suites; a shared landlord or suite number does not establish a business relationship between the providers and the revoked entity.
- One owner holding interests in several home health agencies can be a lawful multi-site or supervisory business structure and may be fully disclosed at enrollment.
- A cluster of incorporations in one 90-day window can reflect market entry after a licensing or moratorium change rather than coordination.
- The Medicare revocation action for Deluxe Hospice Care is dated 2026-04-09 and may be subject to appeal, reconsideration or reinstatement; verify current status before acting.
- Medicaid billing of \$220 in 2024 and no billing for six of the seven providers may reflect data lag, dual eligible or Medicare only business, or managed care encounter data not captured here.
- High county saturation reflects the local market and by itself does not indicate anything about these specific providers.
